## Ex-Secretary of State Kiffmeyer jumps into political fray on health care

Former Minnesota Secretary of State Mary Kiffmeyer is back in the public eye - or at least the public ear - with a radio ad for the new Minnesota Majority.

Kiffmeyer, who lost her re-election bid in 2006, was featured today in an ad about health care during Gov. Tim Pawlenty's weekly radio show.

In the ad, Kiffmeyer said **Democrats** in the state support "socialistic" universal health care, which she likened to a "welfare program." There has been no recent proposal to have the state take over all health care coverage. The Minnesota Majority Web site does feature a health care proposal that state House Republicans, who are in the minority, recently announced.

Minnesota Majority is a political no-profit organization that started late this summer to "restore our Founding Fathers' values to our state public policy. We also hope to establish a sustainable movement that will spawn the next generation of traditional values leaders in Minnesota."
