Dear County Attorney,

I am contacting you regarding an urgent matter which could impact the integrity of Minnesota's election process in November. Minnesota Majority has recently completed an analysis of the voter registration file which raises serious concerns about the integrity of the voter rolls. Although our analysis is admittedly not comprehensive or complete, we have discovered what appear to be a number of serious issues, including:

- Evidence suggesting some voters may be voting more than once in a single election
- Potential duplicate voter registration records
- Registrations missing required information, such as birth date
- Voter registration addresses which appear to be vacant or non-existent.

It is our understanding that Minnesota Statute 201.071 requires "deficient" voter registrations to be corrected before a voter can cast a ballot. Furthermore, Minnesota Statute 204C.14 states that knowingly supplying inaccurate voter registration information and/or casting more than one ballot in a single election is a felony offense.

We have attached a list of suspicious voter records for your county. There is a much longer list of potential duplicate voter registration records which we believe merit further investigation that we would be happy to provide to you at your request.

We are also including an exhibit which provides the counts of voter registration addresses that are being flagged by the United States Postal Service as being vacant or undeliverable. Again, we would be happy to provide the records for your county at your request.

It is our belief that our findings merit an immediate audit of all voter records. Suspect records should be flagged and election judges notified of registrations that should require positive proof of identification at the time of the election.

I respectfully request a written confirmation of receipt of this letter, including your plans for addressing these issues. Please feel free to contact us with any questions that you may have regarding this matter.
