Dear Secretary Ritchie:

Pursuant to the Minnesota Data Practices Act, Minn. Stat. §13.03, I request access to and copies of all documentation related to the following:

- Voter records flagged by your office to be “challenged” in this year’s elections;
- Voter records flagged by your office prior to Election Day as having “status checks” on their driver’s license;
- Voters who have been removed from the voter list from November 5th, 2002 to present;
- The complete Minnesota voter registration list and detailed history maintained by the Secretary of State’s office, including all of the following fields that are available:
 - Complete Date of Birth including day, month and year of birth;
 - Voter Status (indicating voters in good standing, challenged and otherwise);
 - Unique voter identifier number (i.e. Last 4 digits of Social Security number, Drivers License or State ID number)

Since this information is for the benefit of the general public and will help citizens understand how their government works, I expect all fees to be waived for providing this information.

Should law or statute preclude any portion of these requests, consider each requested item severable and comply with my request for all remaining items. If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all refusals by reference to specific exemptions of the Minnesota Data Practices Act or other applicable statute.
