

Employee Freedom Party Platform Resolution

Whereas we have a fundamental right, enshrined in and protected by the United States Constitution to Freedom of Association, and

Whereas every Minnesotan deserves the fulfillment of that right in their employment, and

Whereas every Minnesotan deserves the freedom to decide on their own whether to join or not to join a union, and whether or not to pay union dues, and

Whereas it is contrary to the fundamental right to freedom of association for any government to force employees to join a union, pay dues or pay fair share fees to an organization they do not wish to belong, and

Whereas states which protect the fundamental right to associate through employee freedom are consistently among the best performing states economically with growing manufacturing, increased job growth and higher disposable incomes,

Therefore be it resolved that the party platform should be amended to support the constitutional protection of employee freedom to be put to Minnesota voters in the 2012 General Election, and that this is the party's official position for it's endorsed elected officials.
